NATIONAL FOREWORD

The adoption of the ISO Standard as a Malaysian Standard was recommended by the Technical Committee on Technical Drawings under the authority of the Industry Standards Committee on Mechanical Engineering.

This Malaysian Standard is the first revision of MS ISO 286-2, *ISO system of limits and fits - Part 2: Table of standard tolerance grades and limit deviations for holes and shafts*.

This Malaysian Standard is identical with ISO 286-2:2010, *Geometrical product specifications (GPS) - ISO code system for tolerances on linear sizes - Part 2: Tables of standard tolerance classes and limit deviations for holes and shafts*, published by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO). However, for the purposes of this Malaysian Standard, the following apply:

- a) in the source text, "this International Standard" should read "this Malaysian Standard";
- b) the comma which is used as a decimal sign (if any), to read as a point; and
- c) reference to International Standards should be replaced by corresponding Malaysian Standards as follows:
