National foreword

The adoption of the ISO Standard as a Malaysian Standard was recommended by the Technical Committee on Clean Agent Fire Extinguishing Systems (NSC 13/TC 5) under the authority of the National Standards Committee on Fire Safety (NSC 13).

This second revision of MS 1746-15 cancels and replaces MS 1746-15:2008, *Gaseous fire extinguishing systems - Physical properties and system design - Part 15: IG-541 extinguishant* (ISO 14520-15, IDT).

This Malaysian Standard is identical with ISO 14520-15:2015, *Gaseous fire extinguishing systems - Physical properties and system design - Part 14: IG-541 extinguishant*, published by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO). However, for the purpose of this document, the following by apply:

- a) in the source text, “this International Standard” should read “this Malaysian Standard”;
- b) the comma which is used as decimal sign (if any), to read as a point;
- c) reference to International Standards should be replaced by corresponding Malaysian Standards as follows:
