NATIONAL FOREWORD

The adoption of the IEC Standard as a Malaysian Standard was recommended by the Working Group on Safety of Household Combined, General and Other Appliances under the authority of the Electrotechnical-2 Industry Standards Committee.

This Malaysian Standard is the first revision of MS IEC 60335-2-4:1995, *Household and similar electrical appliances – Safety – Part 2-4: Particular requirements for spin extractors*.

This Malaysian Standard is identical with IEC 60335-2-4:2006, *Household and similar electrical appliances – Safety – Part 2-4: Particular requirements for spin extractors*, published by the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC). However, for the purposes of this Malaysian Standard, the following apply:

- a) in the source text, "this IEC Standard" should read "this Malaysian Standard";
- b) the comma which is used as a decimal sign (if any), to read as a point; and
- c) the basis IEC 60335-2-4:2006 is printed in English and French languages. However, only the English version is retained for this Malaysian Standard.

This Malaysian Standard shall be used in conjunction with the latest edition of MS IEC 60335-1, *Household and similar electrical appliances – Safety – Part 1: General requirement*, and its amendments.

Compliance with a Malaysian Standard does not of itself confer immunity from legal obligations.

NOTE. IDT on the front cover indicates an identical standard i.e. a standard where the technical content, structure, and wording (or is an identical translation) of a Malaysian Standard is exactly the same as in an International Standard or is identical in technical content and structure although it may contain the minimal editorial changes specified in clause 4.2 of ISO/IEC Guide 21-1.
