FOREWORD

This Malaysian Standard was developed by the Working Group on Starches, Cereals and Related Products - Biscuits under the authority of the Food and Agricultural Industry Standards Committee.

This standard is the first revision of MS 476 : 1976 : Specification for biscuits. Due to different processes involved in the production of different types of biscuits, the standard was revised into 4 separate standards as follows:

MS 476 : 1998 : Specification for cream crackers

MS 1433 : 1988 : Specification for wafers

MS 1434 : 1998 : Specification for semi-sweet biscuits and cookies

MS 1435 : 1998 : Methods of sampling and test for biscuits

In the revision of the standard, the following documents were referred to:

- (1) The Food Regulation, 1985
- (2) Singapore Standard 287:1984 'Specification for cream crackers'.

This Malaysian Standard shall be used in conjunction with MS 1435 : 1998 'Method of sampling and tests for biscuits'.

This Malaysian Standard supersedes MS 476 : 1976.
